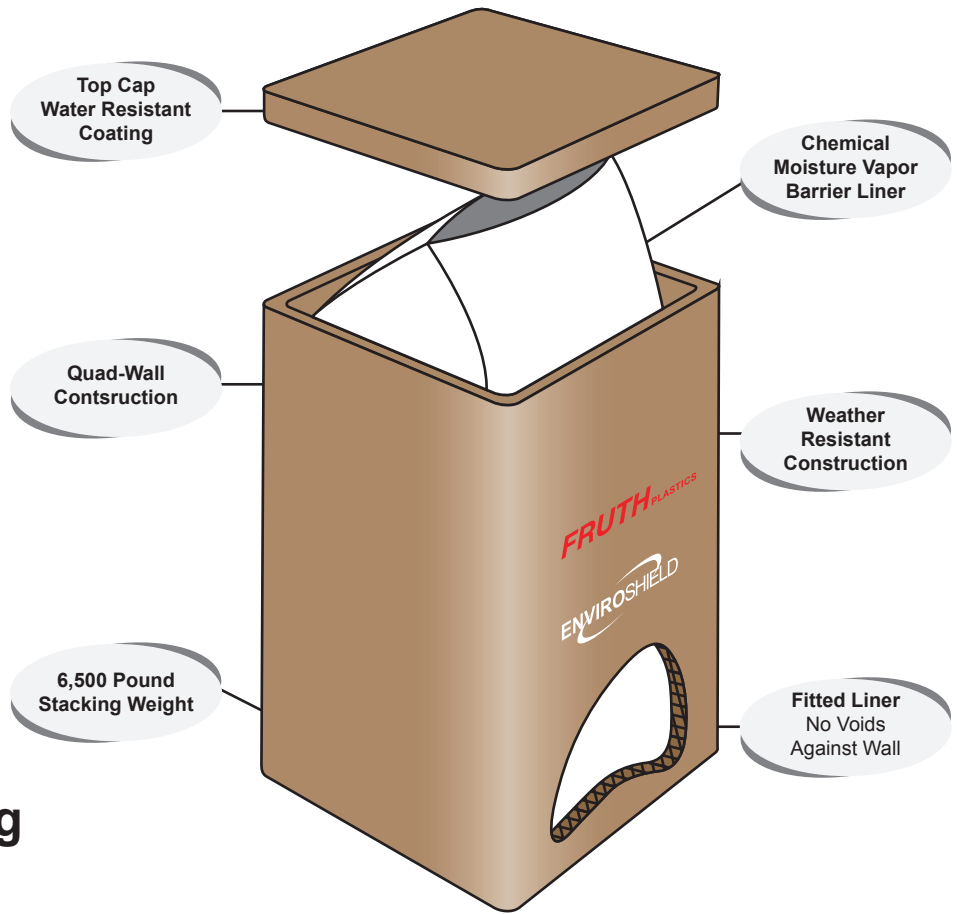

This unique liner is a specially designed laminate that is highly resistant to harsh chemicals, blocks moisture and vapor transmission, and is puncture and tear resistant. Enviroshield provides extraordinary structural integrity and is unmatched in puncture and stacking strength. Our kits have passed requisite third party testing for DOT and U.N. shipping specs as outlined below.
